

What Happens After The Application Is Sent In?

The Trust Manager will check your application. If the application is in order it will be put before the Trustees to make a decision on whether to make a grant or not.



All grants are made in good faith. Persons engaged in the project and or the organisation must ensure compliance of all statutory, common law and diversity obligations. The Avon and Somerset Community Trust shall not be liable for any claim, loss, expense, damage or any legal proceedings however arising directly or indirectly in connection with an award. How Long Does A Decision Take?

The Trustees usually meet in January, April, July and October. Applications need to be received at least 6 weeks before each meeting.
(Exact dates available – please contact Trust Manager).

Applicants will be informed as soon as possible after the Trust meeting if they have been successful or not.

The Trustees may wish to be updated as to how the funds are being spent. The Trust Manager will make direct contact with you if further information is required.

Replacements of statutory funding and salaries

Projects that fall outside the Avon and Somerset Constabulary area

Building costs are given a very low priority by the Trustees

Firstly check your project meets the aims and objectives – it does not have to meet all those shown.

- A brief description of your organisation including details of your management committee.
- A brief description of other organisations involved with the project and any funds they have donated.
- How you will spend the grant and what the outcome for the community will be.
- Who and how many people will benefit.
- How will the project be monitored and evaluated and by whom?
- A break down of how the money will be spent and on what.
- Your organisation's most recent accounts or financial statement including an annual report if applicable.
